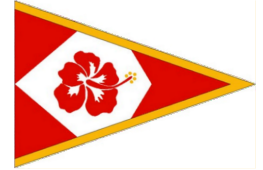

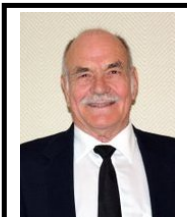
This edition, quiet summer, Squadron Members out and about, enjoying the Florida sunshine, with plenty of pictures to prove it. 6 new members.

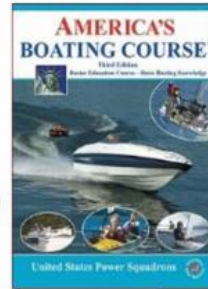
